

# Software training centre to be inaugurated today

**MADURAI:** SAP India, market leader in Enterprise Resource Planning software applications, has planned to introduce its commercial batch of SAP Business One training here on Monday.

Addressing a press meet, S. Soundarrajan, chief executive (strategy), Aldea Infotech, said that SAP had launched its enrolment focussing on the emerging small and medium size enterprises market with its BI applications.

SAP would tap the \$43-billion potential of small and

medium size enterprises market and boost its revenue from 35 per cent to 45 per cent in 2010.
